Dear Parents,

At Imagine Schools we evaluate the academic achievement of our students through student learning gains. We assess each student in the fall and spring (with midterm and winter benchmarking and progress monitoring {every 4 weeks} in between) to determine how much each student has advanced during the school year.

Our goal is for our students to achieve learning gains of at least one grade level each year, striving for more significant gains for scholars who come to Imagine schools achieving below their grade levels.

Starting TOMORROW Wednesday September 7, 2016 – Monday September 19, 2016, your child will be taking the Renaissance STAR Computer Adaptive Test (two days per class, not necessarily two days in a row).

This assessment will provide us with very useful information about your son/daughter’s academic strengths and needs. This information will be used to provide the best possible instruction to your child. For more information please visit: <http://doc.renlearn.com/KMNet/R0054872491706A8.pdf>

The school’s testing schedule will encompass either morning or afternoon testing sessions for students. Morning assessments could begin as early as 8:45, with afternoon sessions going as late as 3:00. Reading and Mathematics assessments will be taken by 1st – 8th graders, and our Kindergarteners will be taking the Early Literacy Assessment. The tests on average last about 30 minutes.

In order to have test results, it is important for your child to be present and on time for all testing sessions. Therefore, this notice is being sent home so that you schedule any appointments after the testing window and do your part to prepare your child to do his or her best.

Teachers will inform their classes of exactly when they are scheduled to test.

We encourage your child to have a good night’s sleep and have a hearty breakfast each morning!
