### **Immunization Information**

Parents, does your child have their immunizations for the next school year? Current 6th grade students will need the Tdap and Meningitis Vaccine to enter 7th grade in the fall, but guess what? All children age 11 and older can get vaccinated now.

There is no need to wait and get caught in the summer rush, not able to get an appointment before the school year begins or have your child excluded from school on the first day.

Now is the time to act! Prince George’s County Public Schools is focusing its attention on our currently enrolled 6<sup>th</sup> grade students to ensure they have the immunizations needed for when they become 7<sup>th</sup> graders.

You can go to your primary care provider now to get your child immunized for the 2017/2018 school year. Other options for you include: going to the local health department clinics, local pharmacies and Shoppers Food Warehouse which will do immunizations for those with health insurance. Additionally, in the spring, PGCPs will give immunizations in the schools for enrolled 6<sup>th</sup> grade students. Information will be sent home in February regarding that immunization program.
